The number of Christians decreased compared to around 1.97 million people from the previous year (Source: https://www.statista.com/statistics/651172/japan-number-christian-adherents/). It's estimated that 95% of Japanese people have never heard the gospel of Jesus Christ. We are going to change that.

Looking in the not too distant future, I will start my long term mission to Tokyo, Japan in March, 2026. I will be helping at the Word of Life Tokyo Church by teaching English classes as a form of outreach, becoming an instructor at Word of Life Bible School Japan, playing piano on the worship team and assisting in any church maintenance. While doing all this, I will also be attending 2 years of language study at <u>Jet Academy</u>, a specialized language school in Tokyo.

I've received the IRS approval of my 501(c)(3) which allows Japan Missions to start receiving tax deductible donations, along with opening up many opportunities to partner with businesses and church organizations. 
